

Frequently asked questions about the Kampfgericht-Management-Portal

How binding is the registration in the Kampfgericht-Management-Portal?

The final allocation of judges, referees and competition managers to their assignments will be made after the registration deadline on February 28, 2025. Until then, you can still edit your availabilities and other information.

How can I specify my availability for my work as a judge or referee?

You will soon be able to choose from several availability periods, allowing you to specify your availability more precisely. Those who are already registered will receive an e-mail as soon as this is possible.

How long does one assignment last? Will I be working the whole day?

This depends on the sport. Due to the preparation and follow-up work, the duration of the assignments may differ from the competition times. In artistic gymnastics, one assignment takes about four hours including the briefing.

Is there any compensation for judges and referees?

Yes, there will be compensation for all judges and referees. The amount of compensation depends on the number of your assignments. You will receive further information when you register as a judge or referee.

Must a participating club provide judges or referees?

Without the commitment of these volunteers, competitions at the International German Gymnastics Festival cannot be conducted. Therefore, we appeal to all clubs to nominate licensed judges or referees for all sports. If an explicit requirement for the provision of judges or referees for a competition exists, you will find the corresponding information in the programme guide on the

page of the respective sports or in the detailed announcements that will follow soon.

I can only register for one sport, but I would like to support several sports.

In this case, please do not register more than once. Do not register for the moment but send an e-mail with the desired sports to wettkampf@turnfest.de. Afterwards, we will contact you and inform you about the following steps.

Does every participant of a group of referees or judges have to register individually?

Yes, because the system is also used for assigning the shifts and billing the assignments.

I would like to support the International German Gymnastics Festival as a referee or judge and as a volunteer. How can I register for that?

Please register in the Volunteer Portal (<https://www.turnfest.de/en/volunteers>) and also in the Kampfgericht-Management-Portal (<https://www.turnfest.de/en/registration/judges>). You only have to fill in your general personal information once.

Do I need a participant card for the International German Gymnastics Festival as a judge or referee?

If you only participate as a judge or referee in the International German Gymnastics Festival, there is no need to buy a participant card. You only have to register in the Kampfgericht-Management-Portal (<https://www.turnfest.de/en/registration/judges>)

All those who wish to take advantage of other activities at the International German Gymnastics Festival (e.g. participate in a competition themselves) must also be registered as participants via their sports club and purchase a Participant Card.

How can I book an accommodation with my sports club or at a campsite as a judge or referee?

There are two options here, depending on whether you will be participating in other activities at the German International Gymnastics Festival in addition to your work as a judge or referee.

If you would like to take part in other activities, you can book the school or campsite accommodation via the admin of your sports club in the Turnfest-Portal. Please note: The participant card will not be refunded.

In case you do not wish to take advantage of any other activities, please indicate your wish regarding a school accommodation with your sports club or at a campsite in the comment field when you register in the Kampfgericht-Management-Portal. For the school accommodation, please write down the full name of your sports club.

In the Kampfgericht-Management-Portal, you must always select the option „Übernachtung in Schule/ auf Zeltplatz (ggf. eigenständige Buchung über das Turnfest-Portal notwendig)“ (accommodation in school/on campsite (independent booking via the Turnfest-Portal may be necessary)).

Does one judge for artistic gymnastics cover the requirements of the registered participants?

This depends on the number of registered participants. For example, if 10 or more athletes are registered for the women's cup competitions, at least two judges from the sports club must be registered for female artistic gymnastics. Female and male artistic gymnastics are always considered separately and judges must be provided for both. Each judge should score at least two assignments.
